

Camp Luther Sr Staff Positions for 2010



These are the job descriptions in brief for these positions

SR. Cabin Leader

June 27 - August 22

(8 weeks @ 65/ day plus 4% holiday pay, food and lodging provided during all weeks.)

- Responsible for new cabin group each week (up to 12 campers)
- Guide and instruct your Jr. Cabin Leader where required
- Lead Bible studies, devotions, options, etc.
- All of the following positions lead their own cabin group each week
- Responsible for a **Coordinator Position**: (Positions are listed as follows)

Activities Coordinator

- Responsible for planning and leading activities option.
 - Each morning the Activities Coordinator will have a 1.5 hour block which to work with. 30-40 campers will be in each block.
 - There are two Activities Coordinators who will together manage, dream up, have fun with, and lead that morning block.

Crafts / Nature / Science Coordinator

- Responsible for planning and leading craft option.
 - Each morning the Crafts / Nature / Science Coordinator will have a 1.5 hour block which to work with. 30-40 campers will be in each block.
 - There are two Crafts / Nature / Science Coordinators who will together manage, dream up, have fun with, and lead that morning block.
- Responsible for acquiring all supplies
- Expected to assist in the preparation of theme night decorations

Waterfront Coordinator / Lifeguard

(Coordinators in this position who hold NLS have a daily pay rate of \$70 day plus 4%)

- For any staff member that holds NLS (Must possess a minimum certification of NLS)
- Assist with safety and maintenance of the waterfront
- Assist with planning and leading all water-related options and activities (i.e. swimming, canoeing, etc.)
- Assist leading weekly simulations with other lifeguards
- Responsible for lifeguard duties
- Responsible for the safety and maintenance of the waterfront
- Responsible for planning and leading all water-related options and activities (i.e. swimming, canoeing, etc.)
- Responsible for lifeguard schedule and duties

Assistant Waterfront Coordinator

- Does not need to hold NLS but some waterfront experience an asset.
- Assist with safety and maintenance of the waterfront
- Assist with planning and leading all water-related options and activities (i.e. swimming, canoeing, etc.)
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- Responsible for planning and leading all water-related options and activities (i.e. swimming, canoeing, etc.)

Program Coordinator

- Lead evening wide games along with Summer Program Directors.
- May be called upon to Assist Program Director with day-to-day program
- Coordinate the Canteen
- Manage Camper T-shirts
- Coordinating Campfires, Drama, Music Etc...

Music Coordinator

- Responsible for organizing all music for chapel and campfires
- Responsible for creating a schedule for each week music teams
- Responsible for planning and leading music options

These following positions are not Sr Cabin Leader Positions

Video Coordinator

June 27 - August 22

(8 weeks @ 65/ day plus 4% holiday pay, food and lodging provided during all weeks.)

- Responsible for the production of a weekly camp highlight video.
- Personal Computer that can be used for editing helpful but not required.
- Competent in computer capabilities
- Competent in Let's Edit two, Movie Maker, Adobe Premier.
- Must be able to work with great discipline and self-initiative.

First Aid ATTENDANT / Nurse

(The First Aid Attendants daily pay rate of \$70 day plus 4% holiday pay)

June 27 - August 22

Qualified applicant must hold min. form of Basic First Aid.

(any single first aid course between 8-34 hrs that provides provincial or national certification and has a curriculum approved by a medical advisory board (i.e., WCB Occupational First Aid, St. John First Aid, Red Cross, NLS, etc)

- Responsible for the administration of medications and first aid
- Responsible for the collection and upkeep of accurate health information and medication administration records
- Responsible for the handling of emergency medical situations
- Responsible for organization and upkeep of first aid supplies.
